- Pat called the meeting to order at 7:24
- All-Star - large numbers of boys coming to game, consider inviting by team next year till filling a 22 man team, well organized,

- From OHSAA sportsmanship committee - original recommendation was not adopted (sit ½ for rest of half for a yellow card), We succeeded in reducing this to sitting one sub opportunity for a yellow, starting in '98 sports medicine training will only be required every 3 year and CPR every will be required to be up to date each year
- Clinic - Gene DeWeese and Gary Avedikian- all ready to go, tickets made for luncheon and banquet
- Indemnification: we have no policy now , a first look at cost was \$1000 per year, will check to see if we are incorporated and for other options
- Concern - benefits for assistant coaches joining state organization - currently only the assistant coach of year award is a benefit
- We will sell Crew tickets \$6 & \$10 at clinic tomorrow
- Pat passed out sportsmanship cards
- Some within Southeast region want to split into south and east - reviewed past practice for the split, considered this the first reading, discussed pros and cons
- Awards - only small changes for next year
- Red cards for boys down by 50, girls up to 55 from 49 last year
- Hall of Fame committee will meet tomorrow to review process
- Message came from Ben Bellman that he has been contacted by some administrators and OHSAA with a desire to move soccer to spring season
