8/18/96 at Park Hotel

- Treasurers report from Bob Ellis- \$6,234.29 was our balance on 6/30/96, this is about \$4,600 ahead of this time last year, Bob reminded locals to get money and coaches member list in! The List is to include Coaches name, School, Varsity/Reserve, Division I/II, Boys/Girls, Home address and Phone number. Bob will send copies will back to treasurers with membership numbers added when completed, The September athlete will have the numbers for division cutoffs
- John Scrambling brought up idea of giving a break for assistant coach's dues after some discussion, a motion by Chris Marsh was seconded by Paul Boll, to reduce assistant coach state dues to \$15 when head coach is a member tabled to next meeting by Pat.
- State top 10 voting we went through list of who will be rep for each division and program. There were many unfilled spots. The first reporting date is Monday September 9th. If an area has a rep for a division/program that was not reported they must contact the coordinators in the following list. The coordinators will be IG Don Skelton Centerville, IIG John Teeter Greenon, IB Brian Stevens Centerville, IIB Mario Gerhardt, (Pat commented that we should get this done at clinic in spring before season), there was discussion how we can impact our ranking on national poll get someone involved as a rep.
- 3 OHSAA commissioners arbitrarily decided to use the 3 whistle system in the Districts and State Finals - after contact from President Pat and others (expressing our dismay at not being consulted and the lack of support for this proposal state wide) they backed off. This is not going to happen this year!
- BG and clinic Pat indicated that Bowling Green was interested in hosting the OSSCA State Clinic. Discussion followed that BG is not logistically a good location; we like Gary's Cooperation at OSU and enjoy the fine facilities. We have no interest in changing at this time.
- All Star game report very little happening Brian is working on the continued sponsorship from McDonalds. Buy lots of Arch Deluxes! We will get officials contracted from a rotationally chosen association, ask them to send their best, and will reward them.
- Roy Bohaboy had forms and distributed for all star nominees and process
- Chris Marsh Moved that we add some indication of membership on national team to the All state nomination form, seconded by John Scrambling. Pat stated that the All State teams were never intended to represent the best players in the state, but rather those who made the best contribution to their High School team. After a lively discussion the motion was defeated by a large majority.
- Info on the new scholarship program was given out at the state clinic. Another copy is to be included with these minutes.
- First Notification (or reading) on splitting East Region in to two regions. Pat indicated that they have completed all preliminary requirements for a vote at the February 1997 meeting.
- Hall of Fame report from Chris Marsh we will go to the old timers and ask for a list of those they feel should be considered immediately (we will conduct a vote on this list) and continue the current process. The nomination deadline is the All Star vote meeting on Oct. 27th (this will be next meeting- weekend of district finals)! Pat requested pictures and bio's of last years Hall of Fame inductees along with the Ron Penshenschaum Award winner be send to him, so he can get it in the Athlete this year.
