- This falls All Star Selection Meeting will be at Dublin Scioto High School and the meeting will start at 11:00 AM on Oct. 26th
- Those attending received a calendar of dates in their packet
- John Johnson report on All Star game it will be on the Friday before state championships, the field may be Dublin Scioto High School, because of the limited time (2 weeks) between selection and game we will need help from the districts to contact players selected for All Star game from each district, we will limit participation to the top 20 seniors from each division
- Hall of Fame report from Pat Marinan districts must submit 3 letters of recommendation and resume for each candidate 30 days prior to Oct. 26th
- OHSAA Update the card rule will continue as is , an ejection report from Ben Bellman was included in the packet from Brian boys need to improve
- Pat made the following motion when the number of boys teams gets to 500 that a division be added with out the wait year (year after 500 involved in tourney) as was done with the girls, seconded by John Scrambling, passed unanimously
- Reviewed the letter from John Dickerson he has sat down with us and is willing to improve fields selection at regional and higher games, will try to have a 3rd backup field, will move boys to Tuesday and girls Wednesday to give more time between semifinals and finals
- Reviewed state poll representatives call in time up to each group leader, contact Brian Stevens if there is additional changes

All purchases above \$200 will require 3 bids and the bid that best serves the interests of the Ohio Scholastic Soccer Coaches Association will be selected with approval from the OSSCA Executive Board. - Working with Pepsi to sponsor All Star Game, our proposal is for \$5,500 for uniforms, The person with Pepsi has already got commitments for about half that amount and has submitted a request to their national people for the rest, we will get at least the half and trinkets like bags and hats from Pepsi, proposal to by 1 ticket to 1 final game for honored coaches and players moved by Gene DeWeese and seconded by Robert Ceran. passed unanimously, Pepsi now has a national initiative to target youth soccer
