

## About the Director

Aron Bassoff is the Head Women's Soccer Coach at the University of the Cumberland (formerly Cumberland College). Previously, Bassoff served as the Head Men and Women's Coach at Palm Beach Atlantic University. Prior to that, he served as the Assistant Men's Soccer Coach then Head Men's Soccer Coach at Dickinson College in Carlisle, P.A.

Bassoff has had a standout career as a head coach. In his first season at PBA, he reversed men's soccer history of six consecutive losing seasons with a record of 11-6-1. Bassoff also helped lead the teams to make history. He led the men's teams to their first Florida Sun Championship, their first NAIA regional playoff appearance, and their first national ranking. He also led the women's team to a 2nd place finish in the Florida Sun Conference, a NAIA regional championship game, and a national ranking as high as 7th. He produced an overall record of 40-34-3 at PBA and had four winning teams.

While at Dickinson College, Bassoff produced a team that finished 17-5 and set a program record for wins in a season. Additionally, they obtained a national ranking of 16<sup>th</sup>, the first national ranking in the program's history.

Bassoff was the Director of Coaching for Premier F.C in Harrisburg, PA from 1997-2001. Under his leadership, the club produced 30 collegiate players, a state-final appearance, and two state semi-final appearances. While at PBA, he was active with several youth soccer clubs and a member of the Coerver Coaching Staff.

Additionally, he has obtained a USSF 'B' license, the second highest coaching license offered, and a NSCAA Premier Diploma, the highest coaching license offered.

Bassoff graduated from Messiah College with a BS in Sport and Exercise Science and has earned a Masters in Sports Management from Nova Southeastern University.

## About the Camp

\*In this camp we will accommodate the beginner, the intermediate, and the more advanced teams for a week of intense and enjoyable training.

\*We will tailor the training at camp to the needs of the team. HS and Club coaches will be asked to give us several areas to focus on to improve their teams.

\*To complement our method, small-sided games and a 11vs.11 scrimmage are extensively used to give players an opportunity to apply the lessons learned in a game situation scenario, and to develop better awareness of the game.

\*Each team will be given excellent instruction from collegiate coaches that know what it takes to play at the next level. HS and Club coaches will have an opportunity to observe training sessions, receive copies of the training sessions and ask questions to the staff coach.
